
Turn the crank, and the roof begins to rise . . . almost without effort. A brake mechanism reduces the danger of free-fall. And there are no awkward arms to contend with.





Once the roof is in place, the end bunks can be pulled out and the canvas positioned.



By easily inserting support bars under the end bunks, extra stability and rigidity is imparted to these wings. That's all there is to it!






A Jayco fold-down's end bunks provide excellent sleeping accommodations. Mattresses are thick and firm; extra wide and roomy. Privacy drapes with attractive color-coordinated valances are standard. There's a great deal of headroom in these bunks, too. And notice the special storage cubbyholes in the lower end-wall. They're ideal for things like magazines, games, or maps.

All Jayco fold-downs are available with optional Evolution 3\* tent fabric—a remarkable new fabric that's becoming increasingly popular in campsites across America. Evolution 3 tent fabric consist of 3 layers of formed olefin fibers which are bonded together into one super-tough material. Extensive testing has proven it to be highly water repellent; highly breathable; resistant to sagging and stretching; stain-, mildew-, and rot-resistant; lightweight, yet strong and durable; and completely odorless. The patio light and wheel cover shown here are standard.



Add even more outdoor comfort and convenience to your campsite with our optional canopy. Spring-loaded poles make setup easy. But that's not all Jayco offers to enhance your outdoor fun. Two of our fold-down models come equipped with slide-out kitchen ranges and all models offer brackets for attaching an outside tabletop.

For a more insect-free outdoor environment, an optional screen room enclosure is also available. It attaches to the optional canopy very easily by means of zippers. A special kit comes with the screen enclosure to allow easy attachment of the enclosure's skirting to the body of the fold-down.



Additional living space and privacy can be obtained with an optional canvas add-a-room enclosure.





Every Jayco fold-down is a model of practicality and convenience. Besides offering an abundance of storage space, it's the only line of fold-downs in the industry that features standard overhead cabinets ... and they don't have to be removed or flipped over to lower the roof for towing. There is also a large wardrobe unit, a vanity in most models, and a pullout pantry for canned and packaged goods. All drawers and doors feature positive-locking catches.

Jayco offers a "Big Bed" model, too, featuring an end bunk that's more than 6 foot square. Four bed supports are provided to ensure strength and stability.



The spare tire is recessed so that the bumper is the most rearward point on the camper for safety purposes. The back lights are flush-mounted for safety and smooth appearance. And Jayco makes maximum use of every inch of the fold-down with lockable rear storage compartments.

If you think all fold-down camping trailers are pretty much alike, Jayco can prove you wrong. You have to look beneath the surface to appreciate the real differences. And it's underneath that Jayco comes out on top!

Jayco was founded when Lloyd Bontrager invented what we believe is still the best lift system on any fold-down. That marked the beginning of Jayco's long-standing commitment to doing things better.

The Jayco lift system operates with a single, easy-to-use crank, the mechanism of which is protected by a lockable hatch cover (1). The entire system is completely enclosed—fully protected from the salt, road tar, and dirt that can create havoc with other lift systems. All the cables (2) that operate the flexible push rods (3) are at floor level—easily accessible for servicing. Lifter posts (4) are strong; made of tubular steel. They also feature nylon bushings for less wear and smoother operation (except Finch and Thrush models).

The lift system winch (5) has a built-in brake for extra safety; reducing the danger of "free-fall" when raising or lowering the roof. So unique is this lift system that it's covered by a patent\* and it's backed by a lifetime limited warranty.

Other great Jayco features include: a rugged 4" C-channel frame (6) with added bracing in key stress areas, and

open wheel wells (7) for easy tire changing and better axle/bearing ventilation. The recessed spare tire is mounted flush with the wall on all models for safety. The heavy-duty, welded safety bumper (8) is an extension of the frame itself. It's not spot-welded like many other brands. Two or four permanently attached and self-storing stabilizing jacks (9) are standard.

Double sidewall construction with inner and outer wood paneling (10) features 2 x 2 bracing (11). The 5/8" exterior grade plywood floor (12) is fully undercoated. Wheel wells are of galvanized steel (13).

Extra-wide flotation tires (20 x 8:00 x 10) with standard wheel covers (14) give added stability. Also, for safer, smoother towing, there's a rubber-and-steel torsion-axle suspension system (15).



And there are other Jayco features worth mentioning, like: smooth-operating, reliable interlocked aluminum slider tracks (16) to brace the end bunks; nylon rollers in the endwalls (17) to make pulling end bunks out a smooth operation; double-stitched

heavy-duty duck canvas and moisture barriers on the end bunks; durable, easy-to-clean vinyl-clad interior paneling (18); an attractive, durable aluminum exterior (19); a city water fill (20) for running water without pumping; a grey water drain outlet from the sink (21); and a 110-volt electric hookup with a 25-foot power cord (22); a 2" hitch ball coupler with a safety chain (23); a hatch cover that protects the receptacle for the wiring connecting the trailer to the tow vehicle (24); and a top-grade vinyl floor.


Not pictured, but equally important is Jayco's insulated, fully laminated roof, which is domed for greater strength and proper water run-off; a 20-lb. LP gas tank with regulator; a patio light; recessed tail lights for good looks and extra protection; and an outside bracket that allows you to bring the inside table outside and set it up for picnicking or preparing meals.

As you can see . . . every Jayco fold-down camping trailer is built to provide lasting pleasure.


