Study Says RV Travel is Most Economical

Pannell Kerr Forster, an international firm of certified public accountants specializing in the tourism and hospitality industries, recently conducted a survey that showed RV travel to be the most economical way for a family to vacation.

Taking a family of four, the study found that an average eight-night vacation in a fold-down camping trailer would cost only about \$436, provided the family stayed at campgrounds and cooked the majority of their meals in their vehicle or at the campsite.

By comparison, the same vacation by automobile and involving hotels, motels, and restaurants would cost about \$1,055. And the cost goes up when other modes of travel are used – \$1,527 by bus; \$1,534 by train; \$1,946 by plane!

Like to eat? Then you'll really enjoy the galley accommodations in Jayco fold-downs. Besides the standard stainless steel sink and the large, 75-lb. ice box, top-of-the-line Jaycos come with three-burner ranges or with a four-burner range-and-oven combo, depending on the model. Two of our Jaycos are equipped also with an exterior slide-out kitchen for great picnics outdoors. In Jayco "Js," you'll find standard three-burner ranges, except in the smallest units, which let you option a range with two burners. And all Jayco fold-downs have extra-wide 33" dinette tables for

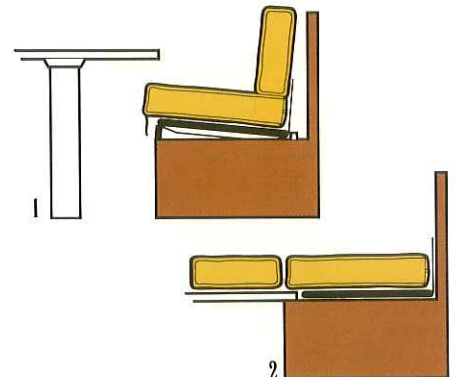
Your family will sleep well in a Jayco fold-down, too. At 77" in width, end bunks are the widest you can get – with plenty of headroom, 4" thick mattresses, and attractive privacy drapes (the latter are part of the Deluxe Option Package in Jayco "Js"). You can also convert the dinette into an extra bed – or the gauchó that comes in some models.

Finally, to make the most of your campsite, Jayco offers you

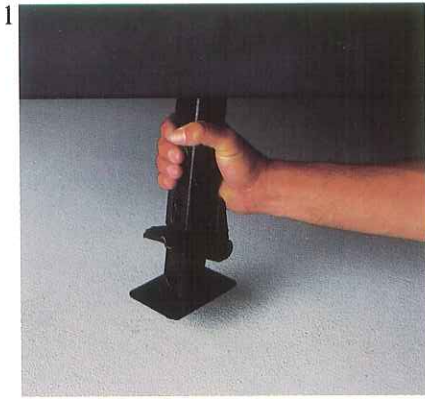

Jayco's unique, patented crank lifter system makes setup a breeze. Before you begin, be sure to 1) position the unit's permanently attached leveling/stabilizing jacks. They swing down into place easily. And because they're permanently attached, there's no risk of leaving them behind. 2) Unlatch the roof. Then open the hatch at the front of the unit, insert the crank handle, and turn it. As you do, the roof will begin to rise almost effortlessly. Unlike many fold-downs, there are no awkward outside arms to contend with. And a built-in brake mechanism practically eliminates the danger of free-fall. 3) Once the roof is up, pull out the end bunks and position the canvas.
