An overview of our construction features will show you why so many RVers depend on us.

On Jayco Designer Series models, high-flotation tires and a wide axle with a 77" track width increase stability. So does the Rub-R-Ride® independent, torsion-axle suspension system. Because its springs are totally cushioned in rubber, your ride is not only smooth, but quiet. There's no hammering, scraping, or wearing. The Rub-R-Ride® independent suspension is now standard on Jay Series fold-downs, too. It's all new; ideal for towing Jayco Jays behind today's smaller cars.

The dinette seating in Jayco Designer models incorporates Flex-O-Lator® springs for greater comfort. **1**) When set up for dining, the seat angles up under the knees and reclines a bit in back to permit a more natural sitting position. Springs increase the support as well as the comfort. **2**) When set up for sleeping, the seat cushions hinge down so they lie flat for a more restful night's sleep.

No cables run through the lifter posts, eliminating the chance of snagging and breaking.

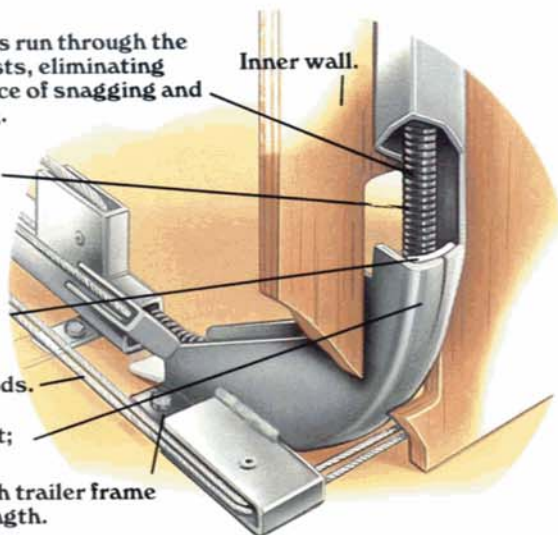

Push-rods are located at floor level and are easily accessible for servicing from inside.

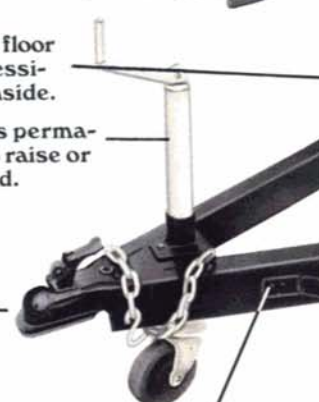
A leveling crank is permanently attached to raise or lower the front end.

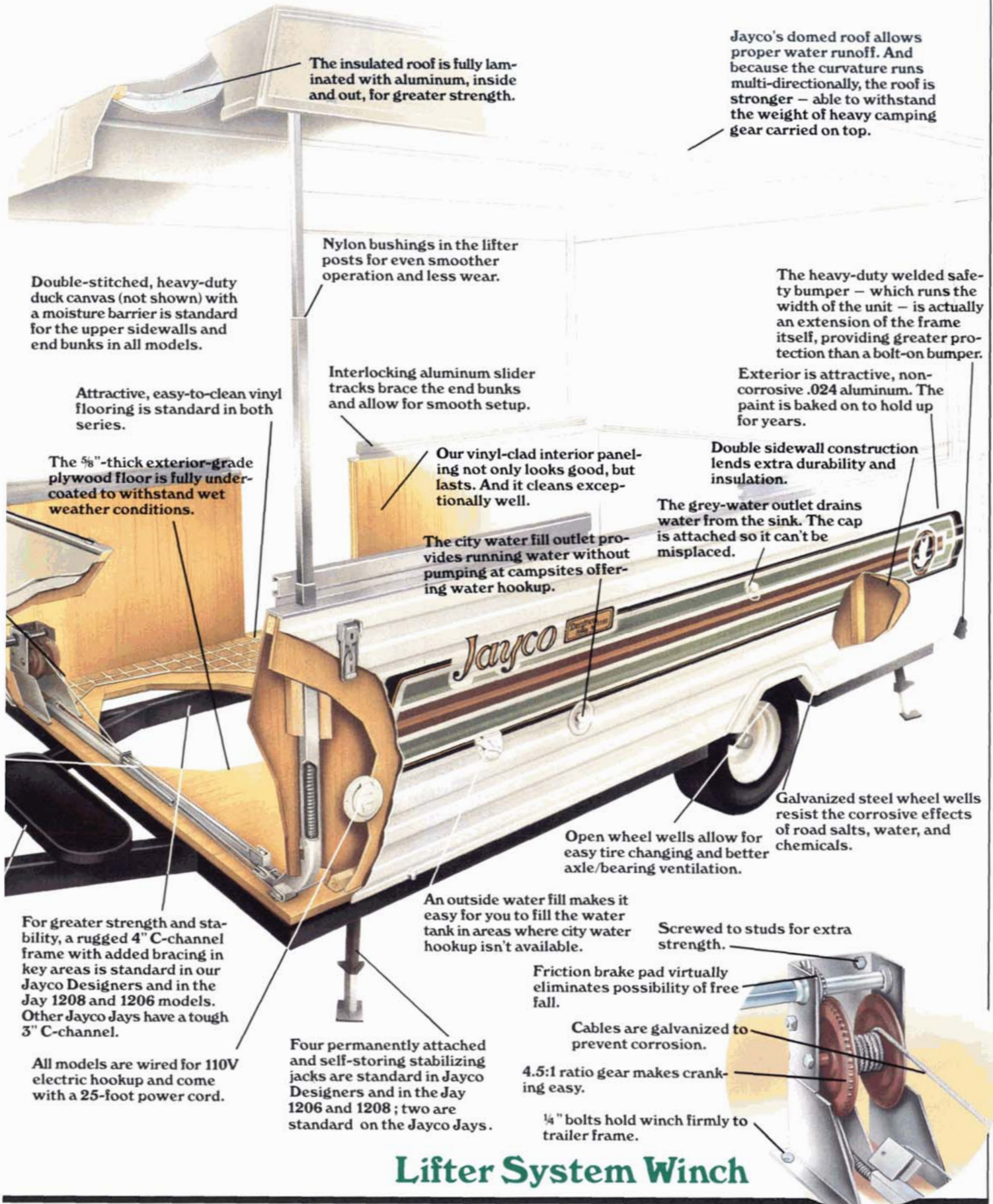
This cap protects the electric inlet that receives the wiring harness from the tow vehicle.

CONSTRUCTION



The insulated roof is fully laminated with aluminum, inside and out, for greater strength.

Jayco's domed roof allows proper water runoff. And because the curvature runs multi-directionally, the roof is stronger – able to withstand the weight of heavy camping gear carried on top.

Double-stitched, heavy-duty duck canvas (not shown) with a moisture barrier is standard for the upper sidewalls and end bunks in all models.

Nylon bushings in the lifter posts for even smoother operation and less wear.

The heavy-duty welded safety bumper – which runs the width of the unit – is actually an extension of the frame itself, providing greater protection than a bolt-on bumper.

Attractive, easy-to-clean vinyl flooring is standard in both series.

Interlocking aluminum slider tracks brace the end bunks and allow for smooth setup.

Exterior is attractive, non-corrosive .024 aluminum. The paint is baked on to hold up for years.

The 5/8"-thick exterior-grade plywood floor is fully undercoated to withstand wet weather conditions.

Our vinyl-clad interior paneling not only looks good, but lasts. And it cleans exceptionally well.

Double sidewall construction lends extra durability and insulation.

The city water fill outlet provides running water without pumping at campsites offering water hookup.

The grey-water outlet drains water from the sink. The cap is attached so it can't be misplaced.

For greater strength and stability, a rugged 4" C-channel frame with added bracing in key areas is standard in our Jayco Designers and in the Jay 1208 and 1206 models. Other Jayco Jays have a tough 3" C-channel.

An outside water fill makes it easy for you to fill the water tank in areas where city water hookup isn't available.

Open wheel wells allow for easy tire changing and better axle/bearing ventilation.

Galvanized steel wheel wells resist the corrosive effects of road salts, water, and chemicals.

All models are wired for 110V electric hookup and come with a 25-foot power cord.

Four permanently attached and self-storing stabilizing jacks are standard in Jayco Designers and in the Jay 1206 and 1208; two are standard on the Jayco Jays.

Screwed to studs for extra strength.

Friction brake pad virtually eliminates possibility of free fall.

Cables are galvanized to prevent corrosion.

4.5:1 ratio gear makes cranking easy.

1/4" bolts hold winch firmly to trailer frame.

Jayco Jay Series fold-downs may well be among the most economical on the market. But you'd never know it to look at them. They're beautiful! And loaded with practical, comfort-enhancing features.

It all starts, of course, with Jayco's famous, patented, easy-to-operate crank lifter system — the same one used on our top-of-the-line Designer Series fold-downs. So a Jayco Jay is equally easy to set up. And once it's up, the living is super!

Soft, color-coordinated upholstery and window draperies with foam backing compliment the spacious, open floorplans. The dinette and end bunk cushions have vinyl backs and are reversible — great for when the kids come in wet or dirty. And end bunks feature high ceilings for plenty of headroom. In the galley,

you'll find a standard three-burner range, except in the smallest models, which let you option a range with two burners. And, as you'd expect from Jayco, there's an abundance of storage space.

Finally, with Jayco Jays, you can choose a Deluxe Option Package to increase the warmth, the comfort, and the convenience of your Jay Series fold-down even more. Included in this package are features like privacy drapes for the end bunks; 4"-thick mattresses and seat cushions instead of the standard 3" thickness; an outside table bracket; and a patio light, mounted on the side of the roof section.

Even without the Deluxe Option Package, though, Jayco Jay Series fold-downs are an incredible value — offering more features and more fun for a lot less money!

A LIFETIME OF EASY SETUPS AND SMOOTH GOING!

Many Jayco owners hold on to their Designer Series or Jay Series fold-downs for ten years or longer. And it's obvious why. Jayco builds its fold-downs to last. With only the finest quality materials. The most time-tested construction techniques. And plenty of innovative design features.

Take our lifter system. For a lot of campers, that's reason

enough to stick with Jayco. Because its unique, patented design makes setup unbelievably fast and easy. One person can do it in minutes! Here's how: Before you begin, be sure to **1)** position the fold-down's permanently attached leveling/stabilizing jacks. They swing down into place easily. And because they're permanently attached, there's no risk of leaving them behind. Note: Do not level the unit until it is completely set up. **2)** Unlatch the roof. Then open the hatch

at the front of the unit, insert the crank handle, and turn it. As you do, the roof will begin to rise almost effortlessly. Unlike many fold-downs, there are no awkward outside arms to contend with. And a built-in brake mechanism eliminates the danger of free-fall. **3)** Once the roof is up, pull out the end bunks and position the canvas. Special tracks with rollers make the end bunks virtually glide into place. **4)** Insert the support bars under the end bunks to give them extra strength and stability. **5)** Now go inside the unit, unfold the upper screen door and frame from the ceiling, attach the door to the frame with Jayco's simple, ingenious double hinge, and insert the upper wall canvas into the groove around the door frame. This interlocking groove system holds the canvas in place much more securely than the Velcro fasteners used on some other fold-downs. Once the unit is completely set up

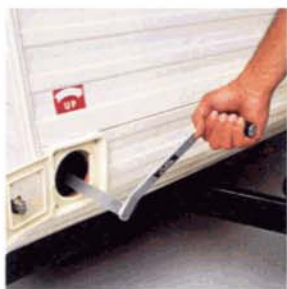
in this manner, you can then level it by means of the four stabilizing jacks. And that's all there is to setup!

Besides operating smoothly, Jayco's lifter system is fully enclosed — a design advance that keeps out the salt, road tar, and dirt that so often damage exposed lifter systems on other fold-downs. This feature also helps Jayco offer a **Lifetime Limited Lifter System Warranty** to original owners. See your dealer for details.

Of course, our lifter system isn't the only reason people cherish a Jayco. They also appreciate that low profile it has when closed. Sure, it saves fuel and simplifies towing. But the low profile also makes a Jayco fold-down easy to store. Just leave it closed in the "travel" position, and it'll fit nicely into one side of a two-car garage — ready to make your next vacation another time to remember... for a lifetime!
