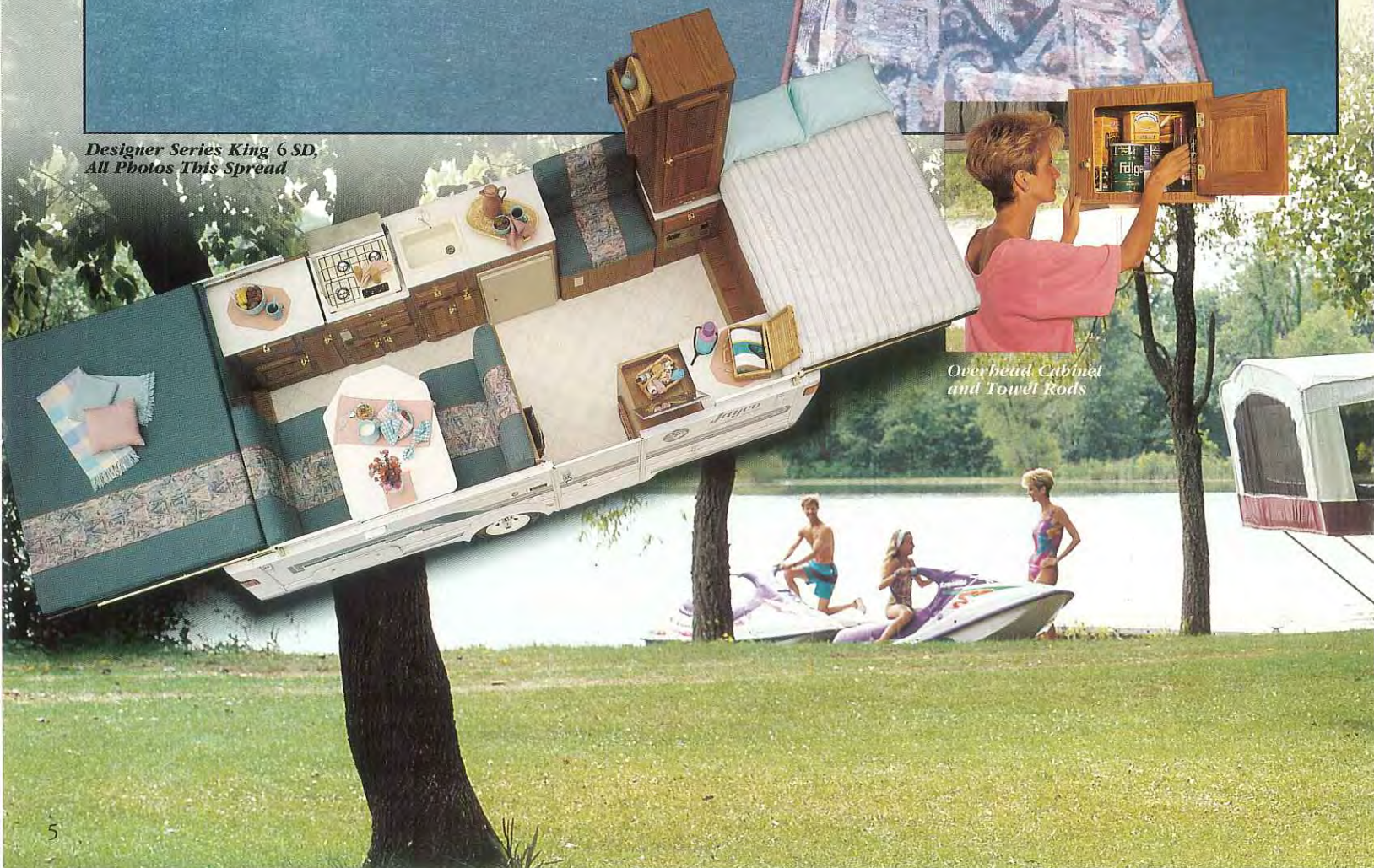

It's fully enclosed above the floor, where it's protected from stones, dirt, tar, and the elements. It's also backed by Jayco's own Lifetime Limited Warranty to the original owner.** And it offers these superb features:

1) No holes in floor for cable access, since cables are above floor (which means bugs and rodents have no access, either).

2) Automatic brake on winch that helps prevent roof from free-falling. You can stop cranking at any time and roof will remain at position where you stopped. An excellent safety feature.

3) Strong, flexible push rods that push up lifter posts, which raise roof. There are no cables or pulleys in posts, so there's no possibility of cables snagging, tangling, or breaking to foul up system. Jayco's entire lifter system uses only about 45 feet of cable and only seven pulleys, as opposed to about 75 feet of cable and 20 to 30 pulleys in most other brands.

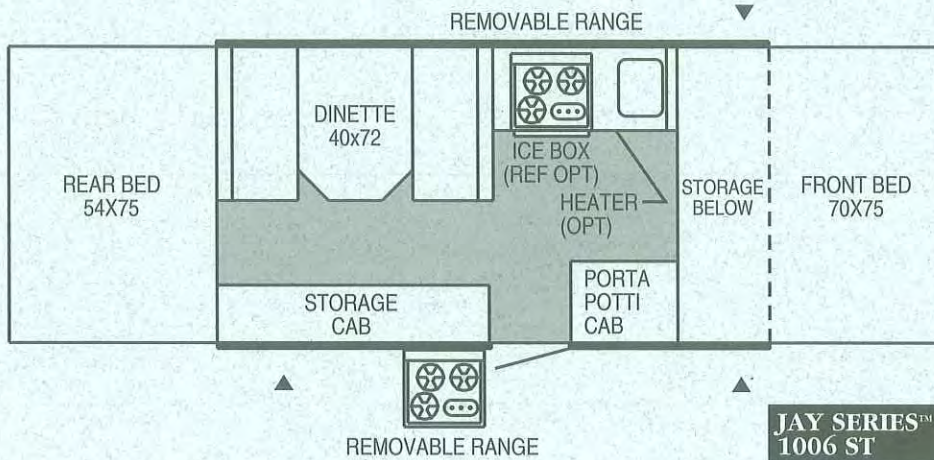

Every year, more and more people agree: Jayco fold-downs are the most completely equipped, solidly constructed, and easily set up camping trailers on the market today.

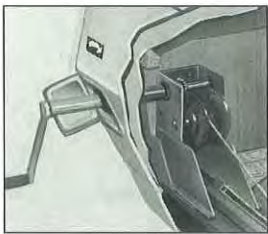
They're designed for the long haul, with more of the durability; more of the style; more of the appointments; and more

of the comforts and conveniences your family wants — for *years* of camping fun!

The following comparison shows you, feature for feature, what major advantages Jayco fold-downs have over their nearest competitors.

WELCOME HOME ... to the wonderful world of Jayco!

THE LIFTER SYSTEM: FULLY ENCLOSED VS. EXPOSED



Jayco's lifter system — comprised of a winch, cables, and push rods — is fully enclosed above the floor. No part of it is exposed to the elements. Dirt, tar, water, salt, and other contaminants can't get to it to cause damage — which is one reason why Jayco can offer its lifter system with a *lifetime* limited warranty. What's more, since cables don't have to pass through the floor, the floor has no holes. So insects and rodents can't pass through, either.



Other fold-downs' lifter systems are installed *under* the floor. Their cables and lifting mechanisms are totally exposed to the elements — and they run up the lifter posts through floor holes, which also let insects and rodents pass through.

PUSH RODS VS. CABLES



Jayco's lifter system uses strong yet flexible push rods to push the lifter posts up and raise the roof. This eliminates the need for troublesome cables and pulleys in the posts: In the entire system, there's less than 40 feet of cable and just seven pulleys. Setup is smooth, fast, and easy. In fact, for over 25 years, Jayco's push rods have proved to be exceptionally reliable.



Most other fold-downs are exclusively cable-operated systems, using up to 75 feet of cable and as many as 20 or 30 pulleys. Cables in lifter posts can snarl, tangle, snaggle, and break. And the more mechanical parts there are — such as pulleys — the more potential you have for trouble.

CRANK MECHANISMS



Jayco's lifter-system crank is incredibly easy to use. It's located at the front end of the fold-down, high enough so you don't have to kneel or bend way over or scrape your knuckles on the ground to turn it. An automatic brake prevents the roof from free-falling.



Typical of other fold-downs is a crank placed under the pullout bed, in the center of the camper. You have to kneel to operate it. And you do risk scraping your knuckles. Also, instead of an automatic brake, some fold-downs make use of a manually applied lock that can be awkward to engage. If you stop cranking without engaging the lock, the roof will come down.

THE SUSPENSION: INDEPENDENT TORSION AXLE VS. STRAIGHT AXLE



Jayco's extra-wide independent torsion-axle suspension provides an exceptionally smooth ride. The independent action ensures that if one wheel is bumped or jolted, the shock isn't transmitted to the other wheel. Ultimately, this means less shock is transmitted to the trailer — and to the tow vehicle. The life of both vehicles is extended.



Leaf-spring suspensions — employing a narrow straight axle instead of an extra-wide independent torsion axle — are commonly installed on other fold-downs. Since the straight axle readily transmits shocks from one wheel to the other, the ride is rougher; more jarring to trailer and tow vehicle alike. Note also that each spring has only one bolt holding it in place. The rear of the spring isn't attached to the unit, but instead is allowed to float freely. Result: Only two bolts hold the entire axle, tire, and suspension system to the camper.

THE ROOF: DOMED VS. FLAT



Jayco's laminated roof is a true dome: It's hemispherical, with a gradual radius in all directions. So water runs off of it better. And it's exceptionally strong. You can install an air conditioner on a Jayco fold-down roof without adding reinforcement. Or you can put up to 200-pounds of cargo on it.

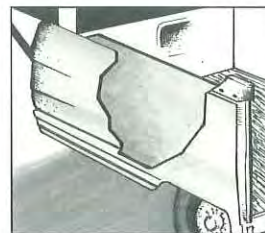


The flat roof of some other fold-downs doesn't allow for proper water runoff. Nor is it as strong. Installing an air conditioner on it or using it to hold cargo requires investing extra money in a roof support kit.

THE WALLS: LAMINATED VS. RIVETED



Jayco's walls are actually "double walls": The aluminum outer skin is laminated to a solid backing. This makes them remarkably strong and durable; especially resistant to dents.



Some other fold-downs have their aluminum outer skins pop-riveted to metal studs. There's no backing on the aluminum, so it's apt to dent more easily. And the rivets, besides being unsightly, make wall repairs difficult.

THE FLOOR AND END BUNKS: EXTERIOR-GRADE PLYWOOD VS. O.S.B.



Jayco's floors and end bunks feature top-quality exterior-grade plywood — with laminated layers for strength and special treatment for moisture resistance. This is one material you can trust to hold up mile after mile, year after year.



Other fold-downs have floors and/or end bunks of oriented strand board or similar materials. They aren't as strong as Jayco's exterior-grade plywood, so they require more frame support. And this extra support isn't always provided.

THE TENT: ONE PIECE VS. SECTIONALIZED



Jayco's tent — made of heavy-duty vinyl and 10.10-ounce duck canvas — comes in one piece. This significantly reduces the number of zippers required. So there's less potential for zipper trouble. And far fewer openings for insects to penetrate. One-piece construction also makes it easier to provide more window area than that offered by most Jayco competitors.



Other fold-downs have sectionalized tents — with plenty of potentially troublesome zippers and plenty of unwanted openings. And please note: Contrary to what you might think, sectionalized tents are often more expensive to repair than Jayco's one-piece tent.

DOUBLE VS. SINGLE STITCHING



Jayco's tent is double-stitched — virtually everywhere a stitch is needed. This gives it exceptional durability. And some seams are heat-sealed with the same process used in automotive convertible tops.



Most other fold-downs use either a combination of double- and single-stitching, with a predominance of single stitches, or single stitching alone.

KITCHEN TRAVEL STORAGE: FOLD-OVER ON DINETTE VS. AISLE STORAGE



Jayco's galley unit flips over and above the dinette for travel. By not having to stow it in the aisle, you free up the floor space for extra cargo. Plus, you can still get into the cabinet drawers and the ice box when the camper roof is down — even to pack food and other items at the last minute, or when you stop for lunch at a roadside park. Talk about convenience!



The galley units in other fold-downs flip over into the aisle, where they obstruct usable floor space and often make it impossible to get at the cabinet drawers and the ice box or cooler when the camper roof is down.

REFRIGERATION: 35-POUND ICE BOX VS. PORTABLE COOLER



Jayco fold-downs come with a built-in, 35-pound, insulated ice box. It's equipped with shelves, too, so you can make the most efficient use of its interior space. And it's self-draining, so there's no danger of food sitting in water ... and no need for the hassle of emptying.



Some fold-downs offer an ice chest, not an ice box. What's the difference? The ice chest has very little insulation, no shelves, and is not self-draining. It isn't built-in, either. So you have to find your own method of securing it if you don't want it roaming around loose in your camper's interior during travel.

CABINET DOORS AND DRAWERS: POSITIVE CATCHES VS. OTHER TYPES



Jayco uses positive-lock catches to secure all cabinet doors and drawers. Result: They stay shut until you open them. And you can't open them unless you push the button on the catch. What you can do is travel confidently, knowing your gear and provisions will stay put — not spill out all over the floor.



A variety of less effective door and drawer catches find their way into other fold-downs. Among them: Simple roller catches and C-catches, either of which may work well enough when new, but tend to weaken and lose their grip after repeated use; spring-loaded hinges which hold a door shut against the cabinet, yet aren't very effective in containing stored heavy items if they move around during travel; and lift-and-pull-type drawers that can be jostled open during a bumpy ride.

CLEARANCE LIGHTS: NUMBER



Jayco fold-downs are designed with your safety in mind. Even the most economical Jayco has a total of 11 clearance lights — including two on each side — for greater visibility.



Other fold-downs offer only four clearance lights, with none on the side whatsoever.

CARRYING CAPACITIES: C-RANGE VS. B-RANGE TIRES



Jayco's heavy-duty C-range tires are designed to accommodate greater cargo loads. In fact, Jayco fold-downs have cargo capacities hundreds of pounds greater than any number of equivalent competitive campers. You and your family can pack more of what it takes to make your vacations come alive.



Other fold-downs come with B-range tires, which don't have as much carrying capacity.

COMFORT FEATURES: VALANCES



Jayco's interiors are enhanced by valances that go all around the ceiling of each unit, covering the tops of the end-bunk privacy curtains as well as the tops of the sidewalls and windows.



Most other fold-down valances cover only the tops of the sidewalls, leaving the ceiling ends bare.

DINETTE CUSHIONS



Jayco's dinette cushions are solidly supported by a full backrest that's built into the dinette itself. They're also reversible: One side of each cushion is fabric covered; the other side vinyl covered. You can switch to the vinyl side when kids or pets come indoors wet or dirty. The vinyl is especially easy to wipe clean. And for machine washing, the entire cover is easy to unzip, remove, and put back on again.



The dinettes in some other fold-downs have no backrests built into them. Instead, the manufacturers slip a stiff board right into each cushion. This board can shift around, inflicting extra wear on the cushion's fabric cover. It also makes the cover difficult to remove for washing — and even more difficult to get back on afterwards, thanks to normal shrinkage. Note, too, that the covers are not vinyl-backed and cannot be reversed in any event because of those inserted boards.

WINDOWS



Jayco's windows have a number of advantages, besides being big: 1) they're tinted, which affords greater privacy, helps moderate interior temperatures, and helps protect interior fabrics from the effects of ultraviolet rays; 2) all of them come with window straps to keep them neatly rolled and out of the way when unzipped; and 3) the drapes behind the stove are *short*, to comply with industry safety codes.



Other fold-downs have clear windows, which offer less privacy, afford no heat relief for the interior, and do not screen out fabric-damaging ultraviolet rays. What's more, they either have no window straps or straps on one side of the interior only, and the drape behind the stove is frequently too long.

MATTRESSES AND SEAT CUSHIONS



Jayco's bunk mattresses and seat cushions are a plush, extra-comfortable *four* inches thick.



Some other fold-downs have only *three*-inch thick bunk mattresses — and what a difference an inch makes!
