CONSTRUCTION

Jay Series travel trailers and fifth wheels are built to provide families like yours years of pleasure — wherever you go, how often you go, whatever you love to do. Superb construction features like these ensure it:

- 1) A heavy-gauge steel frame.
- 2) Numerous steel outriggers for wall-to-wall floor support.
- 3) A 2x3 longitudinal floor system — with joists running lengthwise on edge and cross-pieces to provide extra stability.
- 4) In-floor ducted heating — frees up cabinet space.
- 5) An underbelly of tough, puncture-and-tear-resistant Darco® — much stronger and lighter than aluminum.



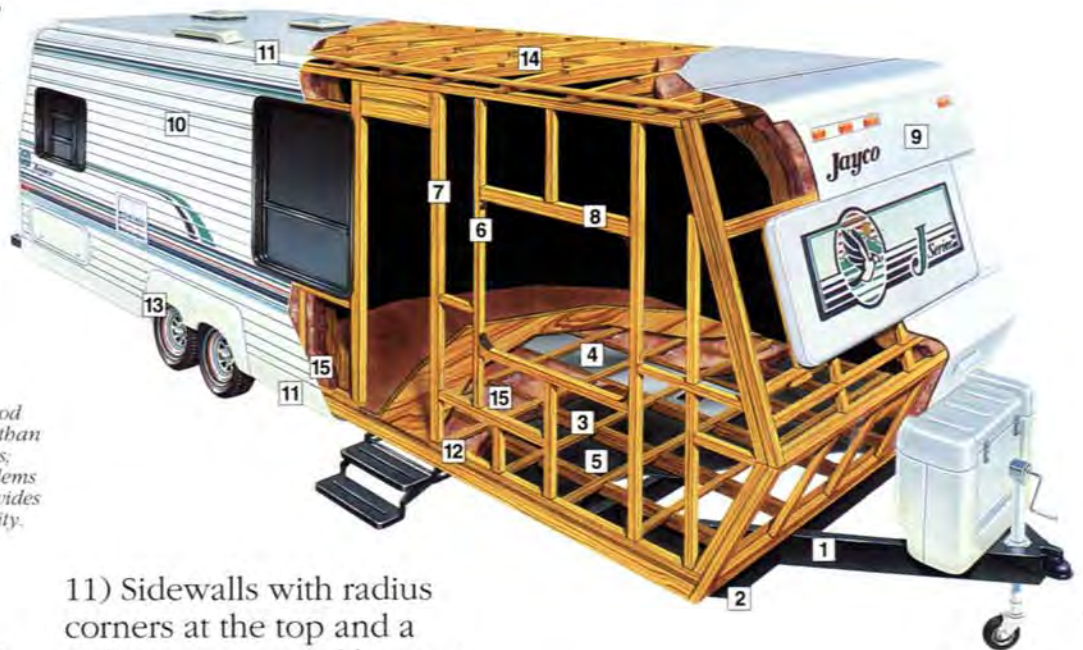
Tongue-and-Groove Plywood Floor. Better than in most homes; prevents problems at seams; provides extra durability.

- 6) Walls with 2x2 studs on 16-inch centers for greater strength and rigidity.
- 7) 2x3s all around doors to maintain the integrity of the sidewalls.
- 8) 2x3s across the tops of all windows for extra reinforcement.
- 9) One piece molded fiberglass front and rear end caps
- 10) A heavy-duty aluminum outer skin — thicker at mid- and lower-wall (.024 inches compared to .019 inches at

the top), so it's more dent-and-scratch-resistant where it's most likely to need that extra protection.



11) Sidewalls with radius corners at the top and a radius wraparound bottom edge — both of which make for a truly great-looking exterior!

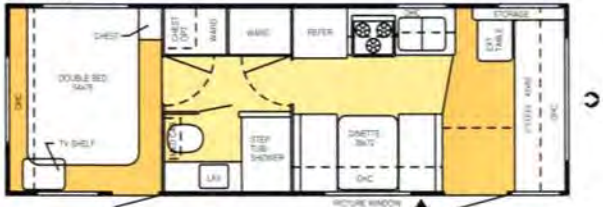
- 12) Walls mounted on top of the floor instead of being screwed to the outer edge. Thus, in a Jay Series RV, the floor, not the screws, supports all of the weight.
- 13) Insulated wheel wells of galvanized steel for strength and rust-resistance.
- 14) Strong 2x4 roof rafters, tapered to provide a slope for proper water runoff.
- 15) Superior fiberglass insulation throughout the roof, walls, and floor — helps make Jay Series RVs ideal for year-round use.
