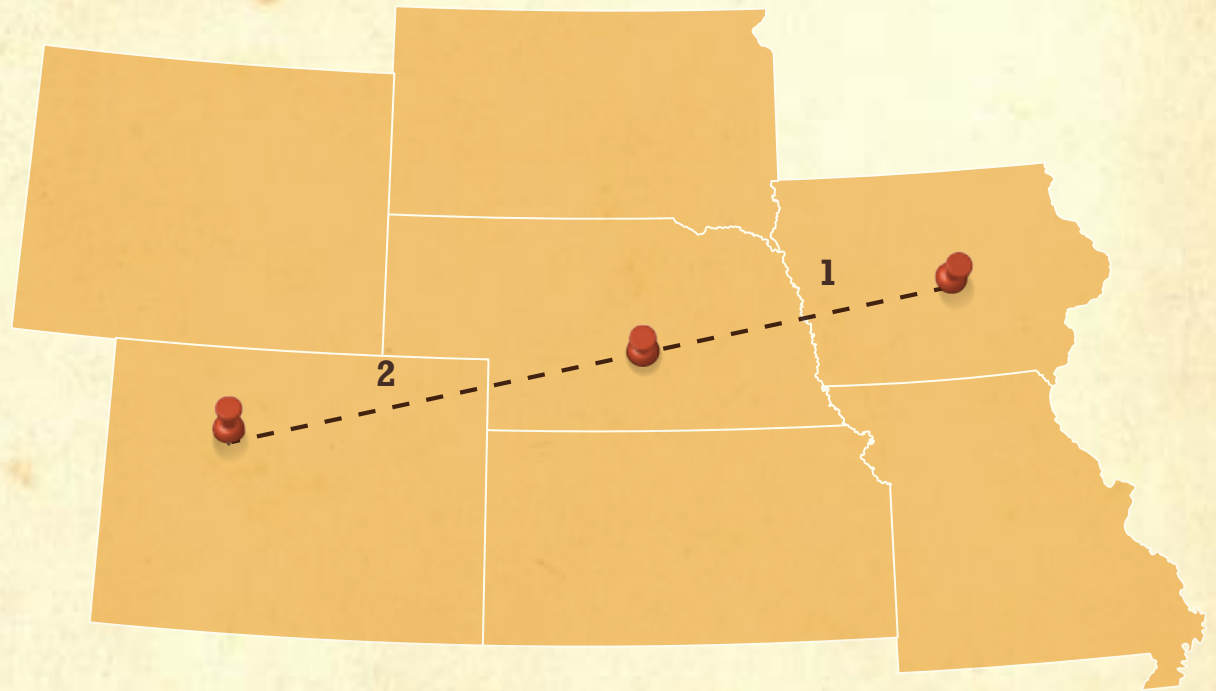

Our comprehensive map provides you our suggested legs of the trip, along with stops for each.

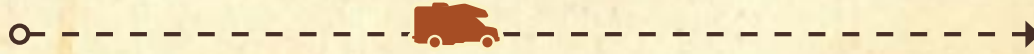
**Total trip and miles:

Driving the complete route takes about 10.5 hours, which we suggest you spread out into two legs. While you're out on the open road you may feel a spark of that good old American adventure spirit, and you may want to take detours or modify the route to fit your travel needs best.

Remember that you can take your time driving, depending on how many stops you'd like to make. We include campgrounds along the way, but make sure you call and make reservations before you get rollin' to ensure your camping space.

WORTH A STOP

The Archway Museum: You know you have entered Kearney as you drive under the giant archway. Instead of just driving under it, don't miss out on what's inside! The Archway Museum presents 170 years of transportation history, and is an official Nebraska Tourist Information Center.

Museum of Nebraska Art: Take in some works of art at the Museum of Nebraska Art. Here you will find MONA's permanent collection which reflects nearly 200 years of history through works by local, national and international artists.

Pull over for these classic cars: Located adjacent to Cabela's in Kearney Nebraska, you will find the Classic Car Collection. These cars are definitely worth a pit stop. You can see 200 historic automobiles from the early 1900s.

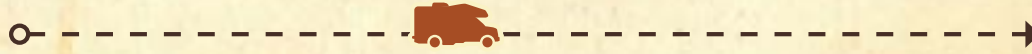

Got a view? Inside Yanney Heritage Park, you will find the Gottschalk Observatory Tower. You won't want to miss the view of the city you get when you're there!

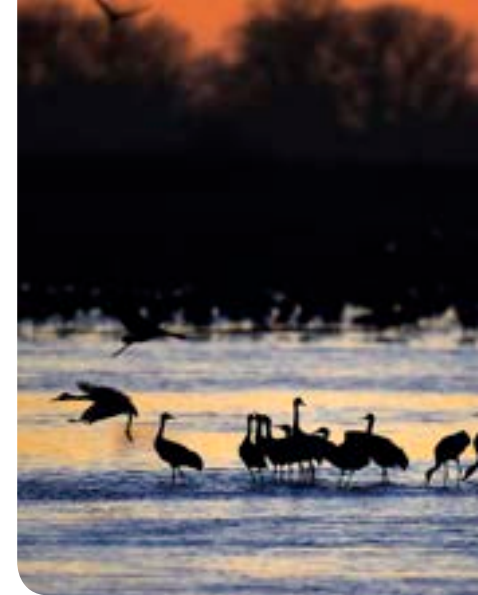

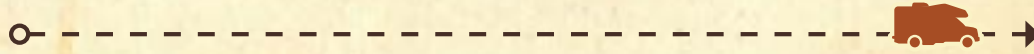

Climb Quandary Peak: It's time to hit the great outdoors. Quandary Peak is the highest summit of the Tenmile Range in the Rocky Mountains. Once you've reached the top of this bad boy, you'll be able brag that you've bagged a 14er.

Up, Up and Away: Hot Air Balloon Rides Ranked as #18 of 50 things to do in your lifetime by the NBC Today Show. Take to the sky in a hot air balloon and discover the magic of the mountains from a spectacular viewpoint. Balloon rides are available in the winter and summer.

Mine Tours: Experience a guided adventure over 1,000 feet below ground in a century old, authentic gold mine. The Country Boy Mine conducts tours underground in the winter. Reservations required.

Mountain Tours: Take a peek at the peak! Learn your way around the mountains with a terrific guide on a free mountain tour. Tours depart daily from the Beaver Run SuperChair on Peak 9 or the Colorado SuperChair on Peak 8.

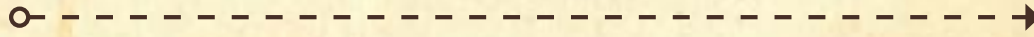

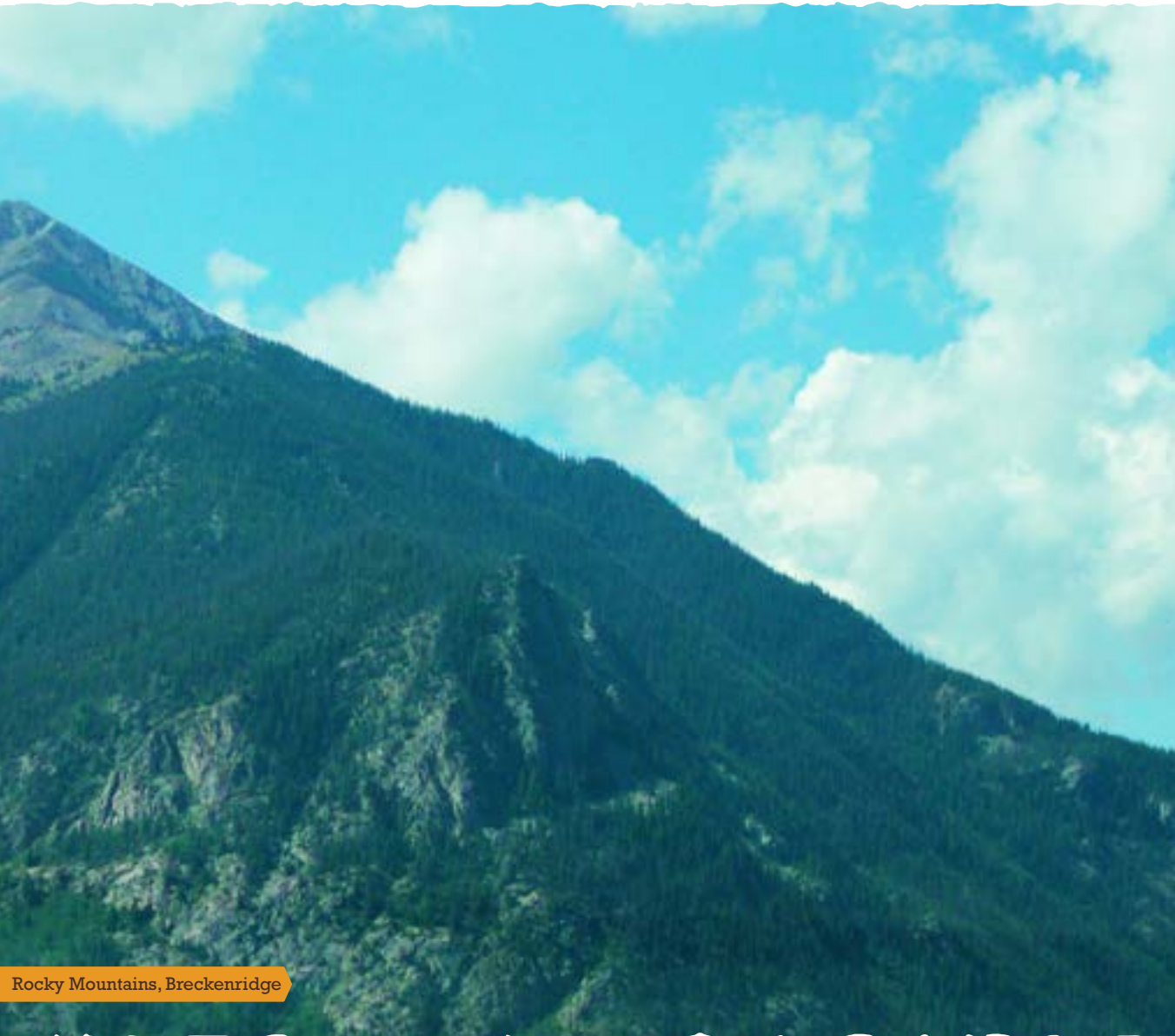
